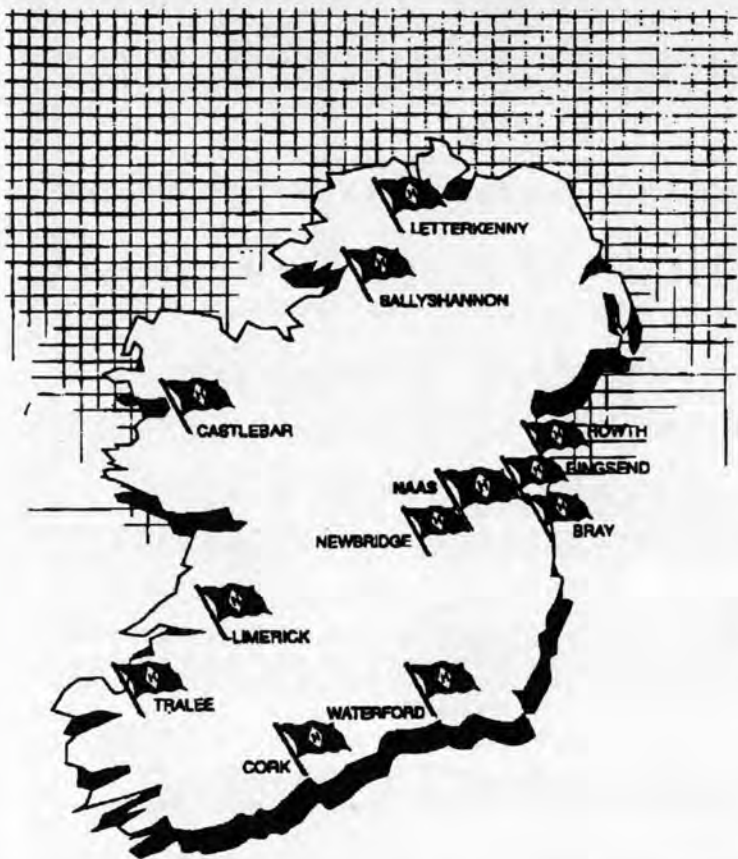

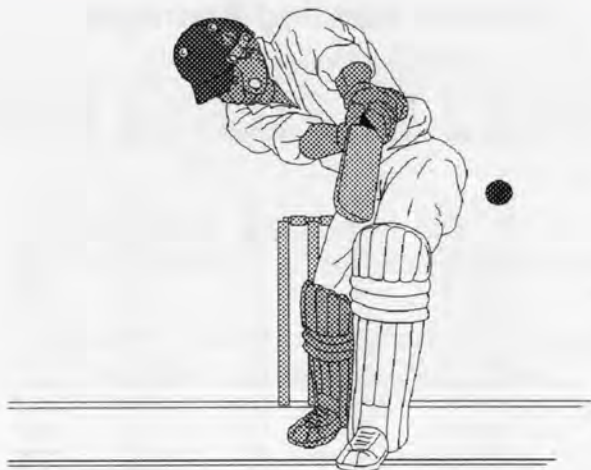

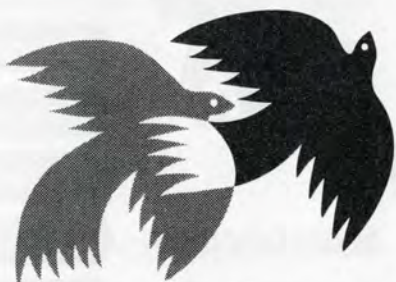

# THE CENTRAL REMEDIAL CLINIC

## *Caring about People*

Founded in 1951 by Lady Valerie Goulding and Kathleen O'Rourke, the Central Remedial Clinic is a cohesive team of people with complementary professional skills devoted to meeting the particular needs of children and adults with physical disabilities and the needs of those who care about and for them.

At the CRC we employ our skills and experience in a multi-disciplinary way, tailoring our wide range of services to the carefully identified needs of each individual and his/her family. These services are frequently, but not exclusively, provided at our non-residential centre in Clontarf, Dublin.

We believe passionately in the benefits of early and continuing assessment and therapy and we work closely with parents, helping them to help their children. Our services are also designed to meet the needs of adults of all ages.

As a voluntary body we represent a unique national resource, one dedicated to liberating the human spirit. Our goal is to assist people with physical disabilities to realise their full potential, to achieve the maximum possible independence, self confidence, competence and personal fulfilment in their lives.

To achieve this we strive to develop and deliver the best possible resource, both physical and human, and maintain close working relationships with other national service providers as well as similar centres worldwide.

*Above all, we are a dedicated team, caring about and for people.*

*The comprehensive range of services provided under the one roof include:*

*Paediatric Specialists, Orthopaedic Surgeons, Eye Consultants, Physiotherapists, Occupational Therapists, Speech Therapists, Psychologists, Teachers, Nurses, Social Workers, Training Unit Instructors, Administrators, support staff and volunteers.*

- \* A Nursery for children of Pre-School age.
- \* A National Primary School with 125 children.
- \* Special arrangements for the care of adolescents and adults with special needs in purpose built Day Activity Centres in Clontarf, Coolock and Firhouse.

- \* A Sheltered Workshop providing employment for 100 adults and producing top quality commercial products in the fields of printing, lampshade and garment manufacturing.
- \* A Transport Section with a fleet of six ambulances to bring patients to and from the Clinic if they cannot come unassisted.
- \* A Canteen serving 400 meals a day.

In recent years, very special facilities have been developed in the areas of special seating, the use of micro-electronics for communication and environmental controls, and the first clinical Gait Laboratory in Europe was established in the C.R.C. in 1990.

The Clinic also undertakes Research into the causes of specific disabilities as well as into the development of new techniques for helping people overcome their disabilities.

Although generously funded by the Government, the Clinic remains dependant on voluntary support, not only for its research and capital programmes, but also for a portion of its day-to-day running expenses.
