No 2nd Round match will be played at Lord's, as Middlesex have been drawn to play Nottinghamshire away (June 7th) if they beat Buckinghamshire in the 1st Round. Matches at Lord's in subsequent Rounds, other than the Final, will depend on whether Middlesex are drawn at home.

COUNTY CRICKET CHAMPIONSHIP Points Scoring

Points are scored as follows:

(a) For a Win - 10 points, plus any points scored in the first innings

(a) FOR A WIN - 10 points, plus any points scored in the first innings.
(b) IN THE EVENT OF A TIE - each side to score 5 points, plus any points scored in the first innings.
(c) FIRST INNINGS POINTS - (awarded only for performances in the first 85 overs of each first innings, and retained whatever the result of the match).
(i) For each 25 runs over 150 scored in the first 85 overs - 1 point to the batting side.

1. 175 runs - 1 point.
200 runs - 2 points, and so on.

(ii) For each two wickets taken in the first 85 overs - 1 point to the fielding side. i.e. 2 wickets - 1 point.
4 wickets - 2 points, and so on.

The Last Hour of the Match

On the final day of the Match, the Umpires will indicate when one hour, including the extra half-hour, remains for play. From that moment the game will continue for 20 overs or one hour, whichever is the longer period, unless a result is reached earlier.

In the event of play being interrupted, the number of overs to be bowled will be reduced by one for every three minutes of playing time lost.

This rule does not prevent the Captains agreeing to terminate the match at the beginning of or during extra time.
